## Diss and District Allotment Holders Association TENANCY AGREEMENT - RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The tenant is responsible for paying rent when it becomes due during **October** each year.
- 2. The tenant has a duty of care to all persons who enter their plot, including family members and children, and therefore must carry out regular inspections for hazards and take remedial action.
- The tenant shall keep the plot clean and in a good state of cultivation and fertility. Where this is not observed,
  Diss Town Council reserves the right to recover compensation from the tenant, equivalent to the cost of
  making good.
- 4. The tenant shall not cause any nuisance or annoyance to any other plot holder.
- 5. The tenant shall not under-let, assign or part with possession of the plot, or any part thereof, without prior written consent of the Association.
- 6. The tenant shall maintain all paths adjoining their plot, keeping them free from hazards and clear of obstructions thus allowing free access. A minimum path width of 2' 6" is required.
- 7. No sheds or buildings are allowed under the terms of our lease with Diss Town Council.
- 8. No livestock or bees to be kept on the plot or the allotment site in general.
- 9. No firearms of any sort are permitted on the allotment site at any time.
- 10. No carpets permitted due to disposal problems.
- 11. No ponds permitted.
- 12. Dogs owned by tenants are permitted on leads only and if tethered to the owner's plot. Dog owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- 13. Fruit trees and bushes on dwarfing root-stocks only (please check with the nursery on purchase), to be kept disease free, regularly pruned and not overhanging paths.
- 14. No bonfires during weather conditions which will cause nuisance to neighbouring plot holders or householders; bonfires to be extinguished before leaving the site; burning of allotment waste only.
- 15. The tenant shall observe the entrance and exit signs to the allotment site at all times.
- 16. The tenant shall observe and perform any other special conditions which the Association/Council may consider necessary to preserve the allotments from deterioration.

### WE WILL:

- ✓ Ask someone for their consent before sharing their personal data
- ✓ If anyone asks to contact you we will take their contact details and then forward it to you for you to contact them
- ✓ When emailing the whole tenants list your email will be a 'bcc' (blind carbon copy) so no-one else will see your address
- ✓ Make it clear that your personal data is staying with the committee
- ✓ Ensure that documents are always filed away or shredded after use
- √ Check that emails have the correct file attachment and recipients before hitting send
- ✓ Dispose of out-of-date personal data securely, eg shred paper forms
- ✓ Regularly review those who can access personal data and remove those who no longer need to access it

### WE WILL NOT:

- X Share your personal data with anyone else without explicit consent
- X If someone asks to contact you we will not give them your details
- X Copy two people into an email who do not already have each other's email addresses
- X Email you with your email addresses in the 'to' or 'cc' fields
- X Pass personal data to any associated body (Diss Town Council, insurance company etc) without consent
- X Email personal data in an open document
- X Keep out-of-date paper or electronic records of personal data
